Director Positions

Director positions open for election this year were **District 1** representing rural members in **Walworth & Potter Counties in SD**; **District 6** representing rural members in **Day, Clark & Marshall Counties in SD**, and **District 8** representing bulk users in **Brown County in South Dakota & Dickey County in North Dakota**.

District 1: Rural—Walworth & Potter Counties

Allen Walth of rural **Glenham** filed petition for **District 1**. Allen is a lifelong resident of Walworth County. He graduated from Glenham High School and SDSU with Bachelor of Science degree in Animal Science. Allen is a farm/ranch owner operator for 40 plus years consisting of a cow/calf operation, small grains and hay with a portion under irrigation. He is presently serving on the South Dakota Cattlemen's Association Executive Board as its Secretary/Treasurer. Allen is a past director of CamWal Electric Association serving for 21 years and 18 of those years he was the Secretary / Treasurer. He is a member of St Jacob’s Lutheran Church, where he has served as President and Secretary. When asked why he would like to serve on the WEB Water Board, Allen states; **“Help maintain high quality water and service to our members in the most efficient way.”**

District 6: Rural—Day, Clark & Marshall Counties

Paul W. “Bill” Wagner, III of rural Roslyn filed petition for **District 6**. Bill is a lifelong resident of the Pierpont-Roslyn area. He was in the service for 19 months; including 13 months in Vietnam. Bill states “I’ve been farming since I got out of service, basically all my life.” He has been on the Roslyn Board of Education for 16 years, belongs to the Roslyn Lutheran Church where he has served in various positions on the church council, served on the Farmers Elevator Board for 10 years and is a member of Roslyn Post #253 for 45 years. When asked why he would like to serve on the WEB Water Board, Bill states; **“Now that I am retired I can spend a lot of time and effort on the WEB Board and all it’s concerns.”**

District 6: Rural—Day, Clark & Marshall Counties

Robert Whitmyre of rural Webster filed petition for **District 6**. Robert is a lifelong resident of Day County. He graduated from Webster High School and SDSU with a Bachelor’s Degree in Mechanical Engineering. He is a Day County Farmer and Materials Manager of Moffatt Products in Watertown. Robert is currently President of Sons of Norway Odin Lodge, member of Butler Lutheran Church, past councilman and Executive Director of SD Rural Business Coalition. When asked why he would like to serve on the WEB Water Board, Robert states; **“WEB has been an asset to this community for many years, providing dependable, high quality water which improves health of customers and their livestock. I want to be part of its future as it continues to serve and improve our communities.”**

District 8: Bulk Users - Brown County in South Dakota and Dickey County in North Dakota

Incumbent Director **Les Hinds** of Groton filed petition for **District 8**. Les is a graduate of Roncalli High School and Northern State University. He is a lifelong resident of Brown County. His professional background includes high school teacher of history, computer literacy and physical education. Les was a high school head boys’ basketball coach and athletic director. His current memberships include American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars and Knights of Columbus. When asked why he would like to serve on the WEB Water Board, Les states; **“I am concerned about high quality affordable water and I am willing to assist in any way that I can. I am retired and can dedicate the time needed.”**
